# Information Technology Systems Support – East Detachment

Treaty Three Police Services is looking to hire Full-Time Permanent, IT Systems Support for our East Detachment in Waabigonii Zaaga'igan First Nation. The Information Technology Systems Support is responsible for supporting all I.T. systems and services within Treaty Three Police Service (T3PS). This includes providing support for all T3PS operational and support personnel while working with an I.T. Service Provider to assist in projects and helpdesk tasks.

### **Essential Duties/Responsibilities:**

- Strong interpersonal skills, with a focus on listening, asking appropriate questions to determine and document client requirements.
- Provide technical expertise and support to client users by diagnosing and troubleshooting hardware, software, and network problems in relation to overall system performance, investigating problem areas.
- Manage and troubleshoot computer equipment, Local Area Network/Wireless Area Network (LAN/WAN).
- Thoroughly document, track, monitor incidents and problems.
- Support Digital Evidence Management in the preservation, handling, redaction, and disclosure of records and digital evidence
- Must be willing to attend and participate in all required training programs as instructed;
- Maintain confidentiality;
- Scheduled rotation to include days, evenings and weekends;
- Other duties as assigned

- Ability to manage multiple assignments simultaneously and have strong organizational skills.
- Must be a Canadian citizen or permanent resident
